

<b>Referee(s):</b>	Provided by and paid for by Nothin' but Net
<b>Ball Size:</b>	28.5
<b>Goal Height:</b>	8 feet; teams are permitted to shoot at 10 feet on their side
<b>Game Length:</b>	Four (4) five (5) minute stop and go quarters
<b>Timeouts:</b>	Three (3) one (1) minute & two (2) 30 second
<b>Halftime:</b>	Three (3) minutes
<b>Overtime:</b>	Two (2) minutes as necessary, One (1) additional minute given for timeout
<b>Defense:</b>	Any ½ court defense is permitted, man-to-man is strongly encouraged
<b>Clock:</b>	Clock does not stop until the ball crosses ½ court after a dead ball during the final one (1) minute of the 4 <sup>th</sup> quarter and during each overtime period
<b>Free Throw Line:</b>	9 ft.
<b>Uniforms:</b>	T-shirt provided by Nothin' but Net
<b>Bench:</b>	Team players and 2 coaches permitted on the bench
<b>Coaching on the court:</b>	Not permitted

**Spectators:** We strive to maintain a facility that ensures that your youth experience a positive, family friendly atmosphere. We are not tolerant of any spectator who uses profanity, antagonizes any coach, player or other spectator or official, or generally disrupts the game.

**Penalties:** **Ejections:**  
A player or coach that is ejected during or after a game by a referee will automatically be suspended from the current game and the next game in the season. A person that has accumulated three (3) ejections during a season will be banned from participation from any service offered by NbN.

**Spectators:**  
Officials will give one (1) verbal warning to the offending spectator. If the spectator continues to affect the game the official will call a technical foul on the offending team and the opposing team will shoot two (2) free throws. If there is a 3<sup>rd</sup> offense, the spectator will be escorted out of the facility by management.
