

### COVID-19 Policies and Procedures

**Notice to spectators, please do your best to limit the number of spectators that you bring to immediate family only.**

1. Players are requested to stay in their car until 10 minutes before their games and practices are set to begin. on game days and 10 minutes before their scheduled start time on practice days.
2. Doors are marked for Entrance and Exit.
3. Anyone entering the facility is subject to have their temperature taken. Anyone with a temperature over 100.4 degrees will be asked to leave the facility immediately.
4. Masks are required for entrance to the facility and while you are inside. Coaches and officials are not required to wear facial coverings when on the court during games and practices.
5. Masks must be worn by Coaches and Players from the time they enter the facility until they step on to their designated game court. Upon leaving the court, they must wear a mask.
6. Once a game is over, teams may not congregate on the court or just off the court but need to move in a reasonable manner to leave the facility. Coaches are not permitted to "huddle" with their team, there will be no hand shaking after games.
7. All high contact surface touch areas will be disinfected throughout the day.
8. Signs encouraging 6' Social Distancing will be posted throughout the facility. Six feet social distancing must be maintained between individuals/family groups.
9. To provide for increased social distancing, the middle row of all spectator bleachers will be blocked off to ensure no spectators are sitting in rows next to each other.
10. In addition to the many hand sanitizing stations located throughout the facility, all guests are encouraged to bring their own small hand sanitizer and use it frequently throughout their time in the facility. This includes encouraging all players to use hand sanitizer immediately before beginning each game or practice.
11. Employees of Nothin' but Net will have their temperatures monitored before the start of their shift and during their shift if longer than 4 hours.
12. Restrooms will operate at 50% capacity, maximum of 4 allowed in the ladies room and 2 in the mens. Signs are posted at the entrance to the restrooms.
13. No water fountains are available for use and players are not permitted to share water bottles.
14. Concession area seating is placed 6' apart to allow for social distancing.
15. All score tables will have sanitizing spray and paper towels for customer use and will be wiped down throughout the day by NbN staffing.
16. If you do not have a mask, we have them available for purchase for \$1.00
17. We ask anyone with underlying health issues to please stay home for your safety and the safety of us all. Anyone entering the facility must conduct daily system assessments. Anyone experiencing symptoms must stay home.
